*³⁷On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. ³⁸Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, ‘Out of his heart **will flow rivers of living water.**’” ³⁹Now this he said **about the Spirit**, whom those **who believed in him were to receive**, for as yet the Spirit had not been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified. **John 7:37-39***

- **Big Idea 1:** We only seek help to the degree we realize our need for it.
- **Big Idea 2:** When we do seek help, where does it come from? Trace your passions to find the object of your reliance.
- **Big Idea 3:** Jesus promises those who diligently pursue Him in faith, will have the source of satisfaction placed in them. The very same Spirit that rested upon and anointed Jesus during His earthly ministry will now abide in us.
