Chapter 1

- The **word** became flesh (1:1, 14).
- The **creator** of all, in whom is **life** and light for men (1:3, 4).
- The **radiance** of God's glory, full of grace and truth (1:14; Heb 1:3).
- The son of God who **dwelt** among us and makes God known (1:14, 18).
- The son of man (1:49, 51; Psalm 8:4, Daniel 7).
- Greater than the grace of law, giving **sonship** through **adoption** for all who believe (1:12, 16; Rom 8:15).
- Full of the presence and power of God, **baptizing** with the Holy Spirit (1:33).
