Selected reading from Proverbs 4:18-27: The path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, shining brighter and brighter until midday.¹⁹ But the way of the wicked is like the darkest gloom; they don't know what makes them stumble.²⁰ My son, pay attention to my words; listen closely to my sayings.²¹ Don't lose sight of them; keep them within your heart.²² For they are life to those who find them, and health to one's whole body.²³ Guard your heart above all else, for it is the source of life.²⁴ Don't let your mouth speak dishonestly, and don't let your lips talk deviously.²⁵ Let your eyes look forward; fix your gaze straight ahead.²⁶ Carefully consider the path for your feet, and all your ways will be established.²⁷ Don't turn to the right or to the left; keep your feet away from evil.

8:12 Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.” 8:12
