



The Jesus Series: **RELY**  
10.14.2018 || John 7:37-39

Hebrew *Sha'an* (pronounced *Shaw-an*) means **to lean oneself upon, to rely on**. It is translated in the OT as **LEAN, RELY, REST** and **SUPPORTED BY**.  
Examples of use: **Proverbs 3:5, Isaiah 31:1, and 2 Chronicles 14:11.**

**LifeTruth:** We only seek help to the degree that we realize our need for it.

**Factors that keep us from seeing our need for help:**

- We have a natural inclination to rely on self.

*"Flesh is the ego that feels emptiness but loathes the idea of satisfying it by faith. The basic mark of the flesh is that it is un-submissive. It does not want to submit to or rely on God. Flesh says, 'I would rather do it myself'."*

- We have a culture that highly values self-sufficiency.
- We have a misunderstanding of God's expectations.

*Indeed, we felt that we had received the sentence of death. But that was to make us rely not on ourselves but on God who raises the dead. He delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us. On him we have set our hope that he will deliver us again. **2 Corinthians 1:9-10***

The reality is that God's aim is **not** to build us up in a fleshly, cultural desire for self-sufficiency. His aim is to grow us into total reliance on Him.

**Life Question:** My help comes from \_\_\_\_\_?

**Ponder this question:**

- **Mentally** – Do I acknowledge that I need God’s help?
- **Emotionally** – Do I love God’s word to me and desire to rely on Him?
- **Will** – Do I practice reliance on God through obedience and prayer? Do I act and then pray? Or do I pray **before** I act when at all possible?

**LifeTruth:** If you want to know what you truly **believe** and **love**, start by looking at what you **do**.

*<sup>37</sup> On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. <sup>38</sup> Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, ‘Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.’”<sup>39</sup> Now this he said about the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were to receive, for as yet the Spirit had not been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified. **John 7:37-39***

**The Feast of Booths**

- A festival of great **celebration**, focused on God’s provision.
  - **Past**
  - **Present**
  - **Future**

*And the LORD will guide you continually and satisfy your desire in scorched places and make your bones strong; and you shall be like a watered garden, like a spring of water whose waters do not fail. **Isaiah 58:11***

We only seek **help** to the degree that we realize our **need** for it. And we will only be **satisfied** to the degree that we **thirst**. Will you repent of any areas of self-sufficiency? Will you practice acts of reliance on God? Will you see your great need and ask in a sustained way for the Holy Spirit?

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
